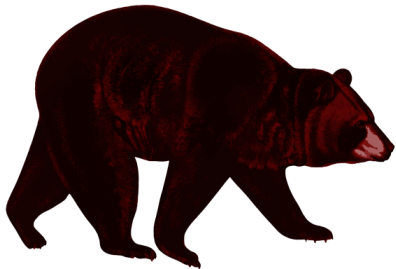

Welcome

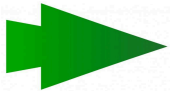
Introductions
